Breakfast items: Cereal, Pop-tarts, cereal/breakfast bars, oatmeal and instant oatmeal flavors, pancake mix and syrup.

Lasagna Soup

1 lb. hamburger
4 cups beef broth
8 oz. lasagna noodles, broken up
1/2 onion, diced
1 bell pepper, diced
1 tsp minced garlic
28 oz. can crushed tomatoes
14.5 oz. can petite tomatoes
1 tbsp. Italian seasoning

Brown burger, place in crockpot. Add onion, bell peppers, tomatoes and seasoning. Mix well. Add beef broth, combine and cook on low for 6–8 hours. Then turn on high and add noodles. Cook until tender, 15-30 minutes.

Serve with a dollop of ricotta cheese, mozzarella and parmesan cheese.
