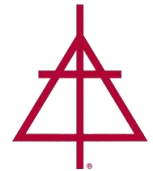

Sermon Series: The Heidelberg Catechism

Sermon Recap: Lord's Days 33 is a sermon on Repentance: The Old Life and the New Life (Ephesians 4:17–24) taught that true conversion, or being "born again," is not a mere change of religion or behavior, but a deep, ongoing transformation in Christ. Drawing from Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 33, we were reminded that repentance is both the daily putting to death of the old self which used to be marked by darkness, hardness, and sinful desires—and the joyful putting on of the new self, renewed in the spirit of the mind. Repentance is not a one-time event, but a lifelong pattern of hating sin, loving holiness, and delighting to live for God by grace, as evidence that we truly belong to Christ
