Sermon Series: The Heidelberg Catechism

Recap of Lord's Day 27: Because God does not change, His covenant promise remains the same: the God who claimed believers and their children in the Old Testament continues to embrace them in the New. Acts 2:39 declares, "The promise is for you and for your children," showing that His grace extends through generations. 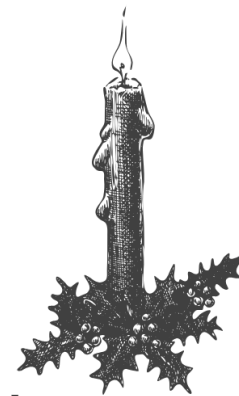
